This fall, Selah High School athletes are not only making the grade on the field, court, and swimming pool, but in the classroom as well!

The grade point averages (GPA's) for fall high school athletic teams have been released and Selah's squads are exceptional! All eight of the high school's athletic teams qualified for academic excellence awards according to Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA) standards.

Two teams qualified for the *Outstanding* category with average GPA's over 3.5, with **Volleyball** leading the way with an average GPA of 3.7008. Also, **Boys' Cross-Country**, last year's academic state champions for the AA classification, once again garnered outstanding recognition with a GPA of 3.652. Additionally, six teams, **Girls' Swimming, Girls' Soccer, Drill Team, Cheerleaders, Girls' Cross-Country**, and **Football**, all qualified for the *Distinguished* category, with average GPA's between 3.0 and 3.5.
