"Do what is expected and do it the best that you can."

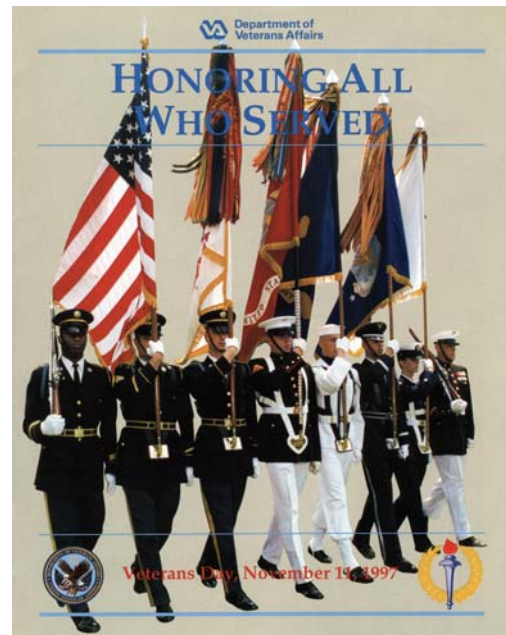

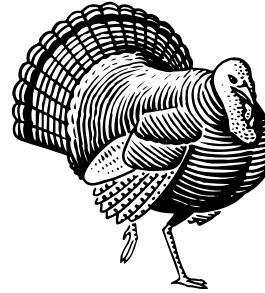

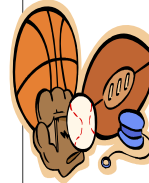
